Scientific skills: you are a specialist for «invertebrate»-paleontology, paleobiology and/or paleoecology. You have strong taxonomic and geological knowledge.

Collection work: You lead a collection manager. You're responsible with her for the administration and care of the collection. You lead the digitalization project (inventory) of the collection. You define its strategic development.

Team work: You work in close contact with the head of the geoscience department, with our preparators and our digitization and exhibition teams.

Research: You carry out research in the fields of “invertebrate” systematics, paleobiodiversity, paleobiology or paleoecology. You run and develop research projects on your own.

Mediation: You work on our new mediation projects and have an active part in the conception and making of our new permanent exhibitions. Mediation is important to you, you like to come in contact with the broad public for guided tours, workshops or events.

Experience: Ideally, you have at least 3 years of post-doc or working experience after your PhD. Experience in exhibition making is an advantage.

Personality: You are a friendly, open and sincere person. You like equal and transparent communication. Working with colleagues with very different backgrounds is no problem for you, and you also enjoy working on your own.

Education: You have a PhD in «invertebrate» paleontology, specifically on macro-organisms.

Language: You speak German or are willing to learn quickly. You master the English language and have knowledge in French (written and spoken).
